Announcement for Winter Term 2023/2024  
**2<sup>nd</sup> year DENTISTRY**

Education in subject ‘Biochemistry and Pathobiochemistry’ in the winter term 2023/2024 for the second year students of the 1<sup>st</sup> Faculty of Medicine, English Class Dentistry program begins on Wednesday, October 4<sup>th</sup> 2023 according to the issued syllabus.

The course consists of seminars and one revision test.

**Seminars** are mandatory lessons (attendance taken) that are held according to the schedule and issued syllabus in the **Seminary Room No. 3.074** of the Institute of Medical Biochemistry and Laboratory Medicine, Kateřinská 32, every **Wednesday from 14:30 to 16:00**, and also every **Friday from 9:15 to 10:45**. Active participation of students at the seminars is encouraged.

**Revision test** is scheduled for the 12<sup>th</sup> week of the semester. The test will contain five open questions on the topics of all preceding seminars held in the week no. 1 to 12 of the semester. A score of at least 60% of all obtainable points must be achieved in order to pass the test. In case of failure the test can be repeated twice more.

**Credit requirements:**

- 1) Satisfactory attendance at the seminars: at most three lessons are allowed to be missed in one term from serious and certifiable reasons.
- 2) Passing the revision test

Failure to obtain the credit will be investigated by prof. MUDr. Tomáš Zima, DrSc., MBA., if requested by the student. The failure to obtain the credit will be recorded to the SIS.

The credit is a prerequisite for the final **oral examination** on the subject ‘Biochemistry and Pathobiochemistry’. The credit requirements must be completed at least five days before the planned exam date. Questions for the oral examination will be announced not later than one month before the exam period begins.
