Tutorials

The tutorial is a form of classes that encompasses an individual interaction between the teacher (tutor) and a small group at most four students that enables intense and effective practice of the scheduled concepts and their applications in medicine. The emphasis is on the ability to reason and connect facts, rather than on the encyclopedic knowledge.

The tutorial consists of two parts: home and presence. Students will receive a worksheet sufficiently in advance (at least a week before the presence part) to be completed and submitted by the deadline specified by the tutor. Then, the presence part will be based on the knowledge practiced in the worksheet, and will take the form of a discussion moderated by the tutor. The presence part of the tutorial should last about 60 minutes.

Evaluation of Tutorial

Participation in the tutorial is evaluated as **passed** or **failed**. The correctness of the completed worksheets only has an indicative value for the students; and is not to be taken into account for the tutorial evaluation. The failure mark is reserved for really unprepared students who have failed to submit the worksheet before the deadline, grossly disturb the course of tutorial, or show really substantial ignorance during the moderated discussion. The tutor decides whether the student has passed the tutorial or not.

For students who fail or miss these classes, one more compensatory tutorial will be organized during the semester. Successful completion of all three tutorials is one of the credit requirements.
