Announcement for Winter Term 2024/2025 2nd year DENTISTRY

Education in subject 'Biochemistry and Pathobiochemistry 2' in the winter term 2024/2025 for the second year students of the 1st Faculty of Medicine, English Class Dentistry program begins on Wednesday, October 2nd 2024 according to the issued syllabus.

The course consists of <u>seminars</u> and one <u>revision test</u>.

<u>Seminars</u> are mandatory lessons (attendance taken) that are held according to the schedule and issued syllabus in the <u>Seminary Room No. 3.074</u> of the Institute of Medical Biochemistry and Laboratory Medicine, Kateřinská 32, every <u>Wednesday from 14:30 to 16:00</u>, and also every <u>Friday from 9:15 to 10:45</u>. Active participation of students at the seminars is encouraged.

Revision test is scheduled for the 12th week of the semester. The test will contain five open questions on the topics of all preceding seminars held in the week no. 1 to 12 of the semester, with special emphasis on (patho)biochemistry of oral cavity and (patho)biochemical mechanisms of inflammation, oxidative stress, atherosclerosis and diabetes mellitus. A score of at least 60% of all obtainable points must be achieved in order to pass the test. In case of failure the test can be repeated twice more.

Credit requirements:

- 1) Satisfactory attendance at the seminars: at most <u>three</u> lessons are allowed to be missed in one term from serious and certifiable reasons.
- 2) Passing the revision test

Failure to obtain the credit will be investigated by prof. MUDr. Tomáš Zima, DrSc., MBA., if requested by the student. The failure to obtain the credit will be recorded to the SIS.

The credit is a prerequisite for the final <u>oral examination</u> on the subject 'Biochemistry and Pathobiochemistry'. The credit requirements must be completed at least five days before the planned exam date.
