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Announcement for Summer Term 2024/2025 1st year DENTISTRY

Education in the subject **Biochemistry and pathobiochemistry** in the summer term 2024/2025 for the first year students of the 1st Faculty of Medicine, English Class, **Dentistry program** (group 1151) begins on Tuesday, March 11th 2025 according to the issued syllabus.

The course consists of lectures, seminars, and practical lessons. Except for the lectures, all parts of the course are mandatory.

<u>Lectures</u> are held every <u>Tuesday from 12.30 to 13.15</u> in the <u>Seminary Room No. 3.074</u>, Kateřinská 32, second floor. There is a tradition to not take record of attendance at the lectures; however, the lectures are an <u>integral part of the course</u> and all students are expected to attend them on a regular basis.

<u>Seminars</u> are held every **Tuesday from 13.30 to 15.00** also in the **Seminary Room No. 3.074**, Kateřinská 32, second floor, according to the issued syllabus. Attendance is recorded and active participation is expected.

<u>Practical lessons</u> will start in the 4th week of the summer term (see the syllabus); they take place in the **Student Laboratory** of our institute, Kateřinská 32, second floor, on some **Friday afternoons from 14.15 to 16.30.**Organization of the practical lessons is the same as in the previous semester: Students are supposed to use the cloakroom in the basement floor and come to the student laboratory equipped with **white laboratory coats**, **slippers**, **water-resistant markers**, **writing tools**, **calculator**, and the **written instructions** issued for each practical lesson.

Students are generally expected to keep familiarity with our **Safety Rules for Work in Student Laboratory**, and strictly follow these rules at each lesson. Students are obliged **to read the written instructions in advance.** Unfamiliarity with the instructions can be considered as a violation of the safety rules and in extreme cases may result in exclusion of such student from the practical lesson (with absence counted).

Credit requirements:

- 1. Sufficient attendance to the seminars and practical lessons. At most three seminars or practical lessons (altogether) are allowed to be missed in one term from serious and certifiable reasons.
- 2. Passing the two **revision tests** (announced separately). At least 60 % of the maximal number of points must be obtained from each test. Two more chances to retake each test can be provided.
- 3. Completed, handed in, marked and approved reports from the practical lessons.
- 4. Good knowledge of the subject matters covered by the course.

Any eventual failure to obtain the credit can be upon request by the student cross-checked by the head of the institute Prof. Tomáš Zima. The failed credit will be recorded to the SIS.
